



RC.2220844-RMACOM: VARIATION

Variations are sought for RC.2220844, Terry Strawbridge, Derrick Road, Kawakawa, because of an unusual anomaly which has occurred during the course of the survey plan LT.592630, being checked by LINZ where it was found that the southern boundary of the adjoining school site, the right bank of a so called one metre wide stream, did not align well with our definition of the left bank of that same stream. As a consequence our client has lost land to such an extent that it has created an orphaned parcel of land which is labelled Lot 4 with an area of 236m².

That has now created the need to provide access to Lot 4 by right of way labelled F over Pt. Sec 2 which was fortunately consented to by the owner who just happened to be the applicant's brother, Paul Strawbridge.

This right of way is to remain unformed as it is only suitable for a tractor or quad bike to access Lot 4, if in fact it would ever be required to.

In addition the existing amalgamation condition, LINZ reference 1819826, will require refreshing by not only including Lot 4 but also Lot 3 which was not anticipated at the consent stage.

"That Lots 2, 3 and 4 be held together and that one record of title be issued in accordance therewith".

Changes to the approved resource consent could be:

Decision A - Subdivision

1. The subdivision shall be carried out in accordance with the approved plan of subdivision prepared by Donaldson's referenced "Lots 1-4 being a subdivision of Lot 2 DP.74675 and Pt. Secs 1 and 2 BLK.XVI Kawakawa S.D, easements over Secs. 1 and 2 BLK.VII Village of Waiomio and easement over Pt. Sec 2 BLK.XVI Kawakawa S.D" dated 4 April 2024 and attached to this consent with the Council's "Approved Stamp" affixed to it as well as the following documents formally received as part of the application.





- 2. The survey plan, submitted for approval pursuant to Section223 of the Act shall show:
 - (a) All easements to be duly granted or reserved.
 - (b) The following amalgamation conditions shall be endorsed on the survey plan (LINZ request reference *******).
 - (c) Lot 3 being subject to a 20 metre wide esplanade strip along the length of the Waiomio River.

All remaining words can remain unchanged to the end of the document.




