TRAN-R2 PER-2 means any crossing not complying with the NZ Fire Fighting Water Supplies Code of Practice automatically defaults to discretionary activity category. Where the crossing is being specifically assessed against a Code of Practice overseen by a third party (in this instance Fire Emergency NZ), the Council should consider an alternative default activity category for non compliance if the approval of Fire Emergency NZ has been obtained.

TRAN-R2 PER-3 defaults any crossing off a state highway, or arterial or higher road to discretionary activity status. However, TRAN-R9 makes such crossings restricted discretionary (where they comply with TRAN-S2). This is an inconsistency that needs to be resolved.

Amend TRAN-R2 activity status column to read:

Activity status where compliance not achieved with PER-2, but where the prior approval of Fire and Emergency NZ has been obtained; PER-3 where the new or altered vehicle crossing complies with TRAN-S2: Restricted Discretionary. Activity status where compliance with PER-1, PER-2 (where no prior approval of Fire and Emergency NZ obtained), PER-3 (where the crossing does not comply with TRAN-S2); PER-4, PER-5 or PER-6: Discretionary.
