Our reasons for this is so that UAV that are smaller than 200kg are not limited in their function in the plan as they provide vital works in the areas of but not limited to safety, infrastructure, asset maintenance, survey, surveillance, TV and Film, Training. UAV provide financial gain to the economy and their use has also improved safety to many fields of work

incluaing agriculture. Small UAV (under 200kg) will provide agricultural aviation to work closer to boundaries and in areas that larger manned aircraft can not operate. However with the restrictions of all UAV from 250g and up this could be a significant limiting factor.
