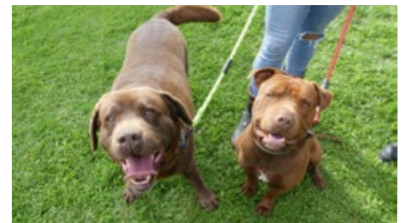

Registration is free for desexed dogs (for their first year, with a desex certificate). Paying between 1 July and 31 August is another money saver – it's the cheapest rate all year! Working dog registrations are also discounted. Search for 'fees and charges' on our website, then 'dogs' within the document, to find out about different registration fees.

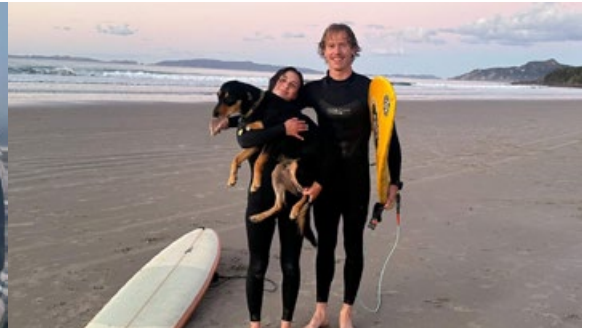
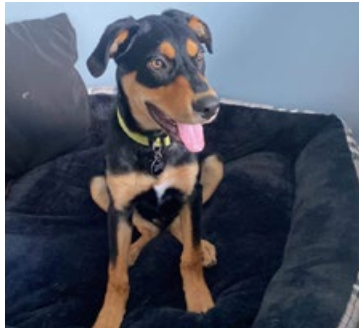

Microchipping magic

Do you know that all dogs must be microchipped within two months of their first registration? Microchipping increases your chances of finding your missing pooch and can reduce the time it might take.

Microchipping is a one-off event and is separate from dog registration.

A 15-digit unique microchip code identifies your dog through registration and the National Dog Database, so let us know your code.
