Submission:

Nearly all of the land that was zoned Coastal Living (minimum discretionary lot size 5000m2) has been changed to Rural Lifestyle (minimum discretionary lot size 2ha **which is 4x the size**)

I oppose this rezoning.

All this land that could be subdivided down into 5,000m2 lots, with the new Rural Lifestyle zone can only be as small as 20,000m2.

The Far North needs to be growing, not shrinking, so we need to provide more properties for people to live on.

New developments and parcels of land mean more rates for FNDC, increasing income and making our district a better, more vibrant place.

1) Rural lifestyle zone discrectionary minimum lot size needs to be 5,000m2 S24.001 and S24.002




