Submission:

Concerns are raised with an evident lack of additional land designated within the proposed zone maps for Rural Residential purposes in proximity to Kerikeri Township.

Local authority decision making must ensure economic wellbeing, and the more land released for development purposes will have a positive influence on supply and demand economics.

It is understood that certain limitations apply to land with versatile soils in proximity to Kerikeri Township, yet it appears large areas of land southeast of Shepherd Road have been disregarded; having not only poor soil qualities (4e7 and 6e9) but upholding a raft of planning criterion, such as low traffic count roading, minimal wetland areas, absence of heritage or amenity values, proximity to the recently upgraded community wastewater scheme, and unique location isolated by existing greenbelt cordon (state forest ~ Lot 2 DP 63173 and Pt Section 9 Blk II Kawakawa.)

Relief sought

- 1) Enlarge the Rural Residential zone extent to capture a further 100ha (this may equate to about 200+ household equivalents).
- 2) In doing so, also add a new standard that requires a 70m wide reverse sensitivity setback for Rural Residential activity in proximity to the Rural Production zone.
