Strategic Direction- Overview of Submissions



- 63 original submissions (with 321 individual submission points)
- 225 further submissions (with 853 individual submission points)
- 131 original submission points indicated general support, 133 submission points indicated support in part, and 25 submission points opposed the provisions
- Submissions came from iwi and hapu groups, interest or advocacy groups or organisations, community members, government organisations, utility operators



Strategic Direction- Key Issues raised in submissions

Key Issues

- Considerations of higher order direction
- Zoning framework
- Importance of climate change
- Urban design considerations
- Objectives being all inclusive
- Inclusion of policies

Recommendations

- Duplication in chapter overviews
- Greater consideration of transport network
- Addition of 'additional infrastructure' to consider infrastructure more broadly

Tangata Whenua - Overview of Submissions



- 23 original submitters (with 201 individual submission points)
- 168 further submitters (with 1,609 individual submission points)
- 79 original submission points indicated general support for the provisions to be retained as notified.
- 39 submission points indicated support in part, with changes requested.
- 62 submission points opposed the provisions and 21 submission points record 'not stated' in response to support/oppose position.
- Submissions came from iwi, Hapū, marae and whānau groups, interest or advocacy groups or organisations, community members, government organisations, utility operators.



Tangata Whenua - Key Matters for Consideration

Recommendations

- Additional paragraph in chapter overview.
- New objective and amendments to objectives and policies.
- Replacement of words in significant resource management issues.
- Amendments to definition.

89 original submissions (with 199 individual submission points)

207 further submissions (with 740 individual submission points)

23 original submission points indicated general support, 74 submission points indicated support in part, and 38 submission points opposed the provisions

Submissions came from iwi and hapu groups, interest or advocacy groups or organisations, community members, government organisations
