Sentiment: Oppose

#### Submission:

Opito Bay is a well established built environment with no undeveloped sites. A number of the dwellings are built to the maximum height currently permitted. Many are located on the ridgelines and beach frontage, highly visible from a wide visual catchment. For this reason the proposed restrictions on development are unreasonable and will not mitigate any effects that are not already existing.

## Relief sought

Delete the rule or establish more appropriate thresholds that are more fitting with the development. ie: do not apply a blanket approach to properties in the coastal environment. I wish to reserve the right to comment further on any new provision Council may introduce as a result of this submission point.
