To Greg Wilson and F.N.D.C team who have foisted this Proposed Plan on to me to which I strenuously object.

I believe part 2 of the proposed district plan is not appropriately meeting of the Resource Management Act and is my main reason for opposition.

I also believe my property at 22 Marsden Rd Paihia does not need your intervention on any of the below grounds you propose.

Not Incompatible Land Use - already covered.strategic direction from part 2

Not Heritage - this is already well preserved - SDCP

Not Response to Growth - already covered - SDUFD

Not Tangata Whenua - astonishingly the Mission area to be included and Waitangi is not, the Mission was a European enclave - part 1 TW

Not the Coastal Environment Overlay- if a 26 m setback is introduced then that amount of un usable buildable area should be rates exempt -CE part 2.

My property was affected soon after I purchased it in 2013 by F.N.D.C Heritage planning restrictions.

Councils previous plan changed heritage boundaries which were consequently challenged and SUCCESSFULLY challenged through the Environment Court in 2014.

Decision NO 2014 NZ EnvC129 was fair and just regarding my property. I cannot see why the pro plan can overturn what was a very expensive enviro court case.

Should this latest revision head the same way and council lose again in the Environment Court then I believe massive compensation should be sought.

This most recent - lets plan together - has so far been a disaster in my opinion, many other concerned land owners have spoken up against the below-

Lack of notice - short response time allowed given we are in an pandemic, while this was extended it was still not long enough for me.

Lack of consultation - letters of notice where not received by property owners.

Confusing, vague and ill researched mapping. Part A and Part B are the same map colour oddly and both have unfair restrictions.

Lack of engagement - councils zoom meeting was a flop in my opinion , lumping all areas in together for one short poorly run meeting .


Indecent haste - rushing this through beggers belief as I see it.

Public meetings are the appropriate places where your team would learn most by listening to the people ie ratepayers.


I believe these massive changes will produce a storm of opposition and accountability for the stress and strain caused should have consequences.
