Notable tree: There is a notable Pohutukawa (Metrosideros Excelsa) situated in Te Hue Cove (otherwise known as Assassination Cove) under which it is said that the French explorer and merchant Marion du Fresne and some of his crew were

killed

during the visit of the French ships Mascarin and Marquis de Castries to the Bay of Islands in 1772. (Ref. L G Kelly, Marion du Fresne at the Bay of Islands 1951, and Dame Anne Salmond, Between Worlds 1994.)

The tree is situated at the shore-ward end of an old wharf and beneath an Historic Places Plaque erected in 1972 on the 200th anniversary of the event.

The tree would be located on Lot 17, DP 41892, Tauri Bay Road Russell 0272.
