This enables site specific concerns about biodiversity matters or conditions to be incorporated into the details of any approved SFM Plan or Permit. Moreover, the level of protection of forest values including biodiversity under the requirements of SFM Plans is greater than set out in the NPSIB. Therefore, matters of biodiversity management will have been well considered and addressed in any MPI approved SFM Plan or Permit under the Forests Act.
